News from Burkina

During the first week of February a woman came to the ACTS Center to ask about Noé, one of the orphans put in the care of ACTS Hope Orphanage.



Noé is growing strong with the care from the ACTS staff and regular meals.

When the boy was called, the auntie could not help from crying of joy. She said:

“Is it really Noé? You have saved the child. I did not know he would live and here he is well and fit... The Lord bless the work you are doing for orphans. You have wiped my tears and taken my sorrows.”

At the end of January 286 widows gathered for a meeting at ACTS church, Temple Evangélique El Roi. They collected locally available ingredients for sauce as an offering for ACTS Ministry. This was a way for them to show appreciation for the encouragement and assistance given to them and the orphans at Saonré.

One woman, acting as spokesman on behalf of the widows, said:

“We do not have words to express our gratitude for all the things ACTS is doing for us. We were left on our own but you have brought us joy as we gather to listen to the Word of God and bring our needs to God. Just as you taught us to pray, I began to speak to God myself. I see that my prayers are answered.”

“We are praying that the Lord will continue to provide for the ministry to bless more people.”

- ✓ Wisdom for human, material and financial resource management as we work to bring in the harvest of souls in Burkina Faso.

We are thanking the Lord for all he has done. He has blessed us far beyond what we hoped or thought. He continues to surprise us with his goodness.
